Practise your **times tables** and Division Facts You need to know all of your times tables by the end of Year 4 😊

Animal Report

What animals lived during the Stone Age? Choose one and write a non-chronological report about it including a captioned diagram.

Stone Age Tool

Using whatever materials you can find, design and then make a stoneage tool for a specific task. You might make a knife, a spear or a paintbrush!

Diary Entry

Imagine you are a stone age boy or girl. Write a diary entry detailing a day in your life.

Make your own paint

People in the stone age had to make their own paint and brushes using natural resources. Have a go at making your own paint using natural ingredients. Tip-food, flowers and berries may be helpful! **Make sure you have ADULT SUPERVISION when picking any berries or leaves!**

Invention Convention

Choose a Stone Age invention (fire, the wheel...) and design a poster to let people know how amazing this new invention is. Use your experience of Project TTT to help you.

Build a Shelter

Build an outside shelter using anything you can find outside. It will need to keep you warm and dry!

Design a Cave

Stone Age people lived in caves. Design your own cave explaining why you have included what you choose!

You may even want to try and build it too!

Book review

Read a book based on the Stone Age. You could read Sting of the Dump, Ug, Stone Age Boy, Savage Stone Age or any other fiction or non-fiction book. When you have read it write a book review explaining what the book is about, whether you liked it or not and why.

Stone Age maths

Stone age people did not understand numbers as we do. Archaeologists have found these markings in cave that they think might be stone age counting. Can you come up with your own method of counting? You might want to choose symbols to mean certain amounts. Will you count in sets of 10 or will your counting system work in another way?
