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| <p>Reading</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Fiction books, novels, short stories - magazines, comics, newspapers - websites, kindles - Non-fiction, information, recipe books <p><i>Please read at least 4 times a week. Ask an adult to sign your reading record to show that you have read at home.</i></p>  | <p>Timeline:</p> <p>Make your own timeline of Ancient Greece showing the significant dates and what happened on them</p> | <p>Remembrance Day:</p> <p>Write your own Remembrance Day poem to put into our class poetry book.</p> | <p>Hare and the Tortoise</p> <p>Read the story of the hare and the tortoise and then make a comic strip retelling the story.</p> | <p>Make a mask:</p> <p>You will need a mask of either a hare or tortoise for our assembly on the 9th December-please make one to wear!</p> |

Can you find him? Create your own version of this picture</p> | <p>Greek God Sock Puppet:</p> <p>Make a sock puppet of either Zeus, Apollo, Artemis, Athena or Ares. Your puppet will need to look like the Greek God of your choice.</p> |
| <p>Learn spellings</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Look, say, cover, write, check - Ask someone to test you. Remember to make sure that you know what the words mean and how you can use them in a sentence. - Is there a spelling rule that helps? - Identify the tricky part & a way to remember it <p><i>Don't forget to make sure you know what all the words mean!</i></p> <p>Spelling quiz on Friday</p> | <p>Book review:</p> <p>Write a review of a book you have read recently.
