

<p>Reading</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Fiction books, novels, short stories - magazines, comics, newspapers - websites, kindles - Non-fiction, information, recipe books <p><i>Please read at least 4 times a week. Ask an adult to sign your reading record to show that you have read at home.</i></p> 	<p>Character Description:</p> <p>Write a detailed description of Hagrid using evidence from the text, include a picture.</p> 	<p>Gingerbread Characters:</p> <p>Follow a recipe to make one or more gingerbread Harry Potter characters. Who will you choose to make? Snape, Harry, Hagrid, Hermione or Dumbledore? The choice is yours...</p>	<p>Life Cycle of a Snake</p> <p>Research and then show the life cycle of a snake. How will you show it? You might write it, make a model or collage, a poster or even a diary!</p>	<p>Diagon Alley</p> <p>Draw and label a map of Diagon Alley. Include The Leaky Cauldron, Gringotts, Madame Malkin's, Flourish and Blotts, Ollivanders and any other places mentioned in the book. You could even invent a shop of your own.</p>
<p>Practise your times tables</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Write, cover, check - Forwards, backwards, mixed up - Ask someone to test you - Roll dice and multiply the numbers <p>https://www.topmarks.co.uk/maths-games/hit-the-button</p> 	<p>Quidditch Rules:</p> <p>Design and make a board game based on the game of Quidditch. You can be as creative as you like!</p>	<p>Hogwarts:</p> <p>Paint or create a model of either Hogwarts or the Hogwarts Express.</p>	<p>Book Cover Design:</p> <p>Design a new cover for the book Harry Potter and the Philosopher's Stone. Make sure you include the title and the author's name.</p>	<p>Owl Facts:</p> <p>Research owls and produce a fact file about all you have learnt. Include at least 10 facts from your research.</p>
