Have you ever wondered how many different places around the world you are connected to?

We would love to find out who in our school has the most links with other cities or countries in the world and so this is your chance to be a detective and find out if it could be you...

After Easter, we want to create a world map display in our school hall of all the places we are connected to. Your challenge is to research, interview and explore how many places you are linked to so you can share your discoveries with us.

You may need some help from your family, but try to find out:

- Do you have any friends or relatives living in different countries?
- Do your parents or family originally come from a different country?
- Were you born in a different country?
- Does someone in your family travel to different countries for their work?
- Which countries have you been to on holiday?

Now the tricky part...can you prove it?

On our display we want to be able to put up lots of interesting things which show the places we are connected to around the world. So maybe you could:

- Ask someone to send you a postcard from that country?
- Ask someone to send you something which has different language written on it?
- Find in a photo of you or family member at a special place or landmark around the world?
- Take and print a screen shot of someone video calling you from around the world?
- Find a souvenir from your holiday?
- Think of another creative way to prove your connection..?

With these instructions are a couple of evidence forms, one for each person or place so we can see what information you have found out and the proof you have. More copies can be provided by school or we have added the evidence form sheet on the school website so you can print as many as you like. EYFS children might like post their findings online on Tapestry!

Gather all your forms and evidence together at home and your teachers will tell you when it is time to bring it in, share with your classmates and start our whole school display. We understand that some things may be too precious or important to leave in school so your teacher will be able to make copies of anything which you would like to share.
