<p>Reading</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Fiction books, novels, short stories - magazines, comics, newspapers - websites, kindles - Non-fiction, information, recipe books <p><i>Please read at least 4 times a week. Ask an adult to sign your reading record to show that you have read at home.</i></p> 	<p>Speech Writing</p> <p>Write and perform a speech lasting between 3 and 5 minutes to the rest of your class.</p> 	<p>Electricity Survey:</p> <p>Look around your house and make a list or a map of all the items that run on electricity. Are you surprised at how many there are?</p> 	<p>Sound Walk</p> <p>Go for a walk. What can you hear? Where are the sounds? Are they near or far? How do you know? Make a record of your walk.</p> 
<p>Practise your times tables</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Write, cover, check - Forwards, backwards, mixed up - Ask someone to test you - Roll dice and multiply the numbers <p>https://www.topmarks.co.uk/mathsgames/hit-the-button</p> 	<p>Easter Story:</p> <p>Create a presentation retelling the Easter story. You could do a PowerPoint presentation, a comic strip or write out the story.</p> 	<p>St David's Day</p> <p>Research St David and find out who he was and why he is celebrated. Can you draw the traditional costumes worn on this day?</p> 	<p>Welsh cakes</p> <p>Follow a recipe to make some traditional Welsh cakes. You might even want to bring them in to share with the class and your teachers....</p>
